

Street Pole Banners Instructions

Products

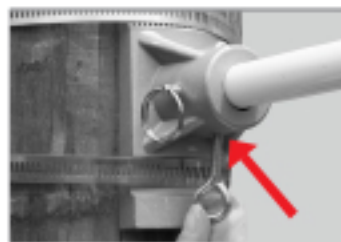
24" or 36" wide street pole banners, single or double set

Product Parts

- 1 - Brackets (x2)
- 2 - Fiberglass poles (x2)
- 3 - Steel bands (x4)
- 4 - Pins (x2)
- 5 - Rings (x2)
- 6 - Ringed screws (x2)



Warning



Please fasten eyelet bracket tightly to prevent wind damage.

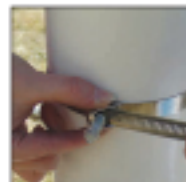
Step 1

Take out all parts.

Step 2

Attach top bracket (1) to pole.

Secure the top bracket (1) to the pole with two bands (3). Tighten the bands until they hold the bracket securely and lock it into place with a screwdriver or nut driver. Clip off any excess band length.



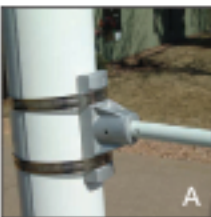
Step 3

Insert the end of a fiberglass pole (2) with the hole in it into the top bracket (1) **Image A** Line up the holes on the arm to the holes on the sides of the bracket.

Secure by inserting a pin (4) through the holes in the bracket and the pole as shown in **Image B**

Attach a ring (5) through the hole at the end of the pin (4) **Image C**

Insert ringed screw (6) through the holes on top/bottom of the pole portion of the brackets (1)



Step 4

Measure the length of your banner to determine where to place the lower bracket.

Repeat Step 2 - 4 to attach the lower bracket (1) and fiberglass pole (2)

Step 5

Slide your banner onto the fiberglass poles (2).

Optional:

Secure the banner on the top and bottom by threading a tie through the Ring (5) and the grommet on your banner.



Please note:

If your banner does not include grommets, please ensure the banner is pulled tight between the two poles so that the banner stays in place, especially during inclement weather.
